

"12 Steps to a Professional Air Duct Cleaning Job!"

Each of these twelve steps is a part of our 100% guaranteed air duct cleaning service.

Step 1. INFORMATION & PRICING

This step is where we gather the necessary information about your home in order to educate you on the proper method of duct cleaning. Pricing can be quoted over the phone. In some cases, a free, in home estimate may be needed.



Step 2. MEET THE CREW

The 2nd step in our 12 step program is meeting the crew coming into your home. AADS employees arrive in uniform and are knowledgeable, personable and honest.



Step 3. THE CLEANING SYSTEM

With the trailer mounted cleaning system, all the dirt removed from your home goes directly into the outside collection unit. This unit is among the most powerful systems available in the industry.



Step 4. TRAINED TECHNICIANS

AADS's technicians are experienced in the latest procedures and the most affective cleaning tools.



Step 5. SET UP & PROTECTION

Work doesn't begin until the floors, doorways and corners are protected against dirt and scuff marks. Protective shoe covers are worn at all times.

All supply registers and return grills are sealed with plastic. This prevents any debris from escaping into the living space.



Step 6. THE HOOK UP

After the system is sealed, an 8" vacuum hose is attached. This will be the collection point for all the dirt in the HVAC system. A protective blocker is placed above the A/C coil to prevent dirt and debris from falling into the coil box.



Step 7. SUPPLY AIR

Once the vacuum is up and running, we send the patented "Duct-Whip" cleaning system into each supply branch to break up the dirt inside the system. The loosened debris is then pushed into the main trunk lines by the compressed air coming out of the whip leads.



Step 8. COLD AIR RETURNS

Now that the supply registers are clean, we continue the "Duct-Whip" cleaning on all cold air return grills. The return air side of the system always has the largest amount of debris.



Step 9. HAND CLEANING

After the ductwork is cleaned, we hand wash each register cover and register boot with an all natural cleaning agent.



Step 10. MAIN TRUNK LINES

Once the dirt is pushed into the basement lines, we then continue to run the Duct-Whip into all the main trunk lines. We start at the far end and work our way back towards the furnace where the large vacuum hose is attached.



Step 11. FURNACE CLEANING

The duct cleaning service is completed with the air washing of the furnace blower motor, A/C coil and filter.



Step 12. WRAPPING UP!

Galvanized access panels are installed over the openings. Smaller holes are sealed up with plastic cup plugs. We then sweep the floors and remove any debris and then place a sticker on the furnace showing the date of service and next recommended cleaning.
